

Medicaid Eligibility For Home Care & Other Services

You're facing a terrible dilemma. Your mother is about to be discharged from the hospital and will need 24-hour-a-day home care services in order to remain safely at home. Your mother has \$100,000 in savings, but home care will cost you over \$4,000 a month. You wonder – is there a program that could help my mother stay in her own home? Actually there is...

Medicaid provides medical assistance to people meeting certain income and resource criteria. Coverage includes hospital care, nursinghome care, dental care, prescription drugs and a variety of home care services.

On Thursday, October 21, 2010, OSA staffer John Turley will help you navigate the complexities of Medicaid eligibility for home care and other services. He will also examine changes in eligibility brought about by the Deficit Reduction Act of 2005 (DRA), especially in the transfers of assets. These changes primarily affect nursing home eligibility. John will answer questions following his presentation.

John Turley worked for 40 years for the Medical Assistance Program, recently retiring as the Director of Field Operations for the Home Care Services Program.
