We support health care reform and congratulate our New York State Congressional Delegation for leading the way. But the current Senate Bill will harm New York State and New York City and threaten public health care facilities, including HHC.

NY will not receive its needed share of federal funds like other states. The Senate bill could add close to \$ 1 billion in State Medicaid costs to NY leading to a reduction in payments to hospitals, nursing homes, home health agencies and community clinics. This can also result in significant patient care service cuts, and closing of all HHC community clinics and ending of its home care service, as well as layoffs.
