Classes of Positions

Classes of positions covered
by the Alternative Career and
Salary Pay Plan Regulations

The Director of Management and Budget, the City Personnel Director and all other Officers or agencies of the City having any jurisdiction over the matters provided in this Order are hereby requested, pursuant to the powers vested in them, to take the steps necessary to effectuate the provisions of this Order.

16. "General Pay Plan Regulations". The General Pay Plan Regulations adopted by the Board of Estimate on June 23, 1955, (Cal. No. 498), as amended.
17. "Implementing Personnel Order". The Personnel Order Implementing an agreement.
18. "Labor Relations Order". An Implementing Personnel Order.

III. Application. These regulations shall apply to career and salary plan employees as to whom an Implementing Personnel Order has been or shall be issued establishing a pay plan upon a basis other than the Paragraph V Salary Increment Scales and the General Pay Plan Regulations.

IV. Powers and Duties of the Civil Service Commission and the Personnel Director.

The City Civil Service Commission and the Personnel Director, respectively, shall have the powers and duties, in relation to these regulations, vested in them by the Civil Service Law and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, the New York City Charter, and the provisions of these regulations.

V. Appointments, Reinstatements, Promotions, Demotions, and Transfers.

1. Appointments and reinstatements shall be made at the minimum basic salary for the respective class of positions to which such appointments or reinstatements are made, as set forth in the Implementing Personnel Order or as otherwise authorized for a specific position or positions by a Certificate of the Mayor. In the event that a different appointment or reinstatement salary is authorized for a specific position or positions by a Certificate of the Mayor as herein provided, no other employee in a position in the same class of positions receiving a rate different from the rate authorized in such certificate shall be automatically entitled to have his salary adjusted to the rate or rates authorized in such certificate for the specific position or positions.
- 2.a) Promotions shall be made at the minimum basic salary for the class of positions to which such promotions are made, or at the basic salary received in the former class of positions, whichever is greater, or as otherwise authorized by the Implementing Personnel Order or by Certificate of the Mayor, but in no case shall the basic salary exceed the maximum basic salary of the new class of positions.
