Whereas, the purpose of the New York State Civil Service law is to provide a permanent government work force selected through competitive exams for merit and fitness and

Whereas certain agencies of the City of New York are using the "one in three rule" to reject candidates in large numbers, and thereafter appoint, provisionally, persons never tested for merit nor fitness and

Whereas, "exhausting" a promotional list through use of the one in three rule and promoting, thereafter, untested persons is wrong therefore be it

Resolved that the New York State AFL-CIO support legislation to require New York City agencies, once an agency promotional list is exhausted, to restore all candidates, who have requested restoration, to the appropriate list for further consideration.
