(DEVA)

Since the DEVA process began, numerous problems have resulted, one problem being that individuals have never received a form due to multiple people having the same name. The second situation occurs when the initial City mail is sent back to the City because it was undeliverable (i.e. person does not live at the noted address). There are at least 2,400 cases of this occurring as of now.

Our agreement with the City provides that no one will be dropped until after the appeal process has been resolved. **NO ONE WILL BE DROPPED FROM COVERAGE ON OCTOBER 1, 2013 AND COVERAGE WILL CONTINUE UNTIL THE APPEAL(S) ARE RESOLVED.**
